The board will count the ballots at the September board meeting.

The process will be

1. verify envelope with member roster
2. open envelope and remove folded ballot and place in a receptacle.
3. once all ballots are in the receptacle, remove and count, and tabulate them.

Any concerned member is welcome to attend the board meeting to observe the counting and tabulating of the ballots.
