FROM SHERRY HOWARD:

We (the Board Members) wanted to share the results of the memberships' vote regarding the look of our club logo.

Out of 61 ballots sent out, 54 ballots were returned. We had one person read off the name on the return address and the Recording Secretary checked their name off the eligible vote list as a Single or Family vote. Another person slit open the envelope and confirmed if it contained one or two ballots per the list.

The folded ballots were removed from the envelopes and set in a pile. The ballots were

then given to two other Board members who opened the ballots and separated them into piles of "keep as is" and "remove the noose". The results were 33 to keep as is, 19 to remove the noose and one that wished to abstain a vote. There was one envelope that we could not include in the vote count due to a missing return address. We could not validate the voter was on the eligible vote list. Obviously from the vote results that ballot would not have changed the results.

For now, our Logo will remain as it has been for the almost 40 years this club has been in Placerville.

Thank you all who took the time to express your opinion in this matter. You are the heart of this club and your opinion is important to us.

We did have two ballots that offered a possible replacement image for the logo of replacing the tree with the Bell Tower in downtown Placerville. Thank you for showing your creativity in this matter.

On a totally separate note, I need to report two of our Board members submitted their resignations from the Board effective immediately due to separate personal reasons.
